Calypso Judging Criteria

The Criteria for judging is as follows:

- Lyrics 40 points
- Music 30 points
- Performance 25 points
 - **Total** 95

The Lyrics section is categorised into four areas:

- 1. <u>LYRICS</u> 40 points:
 - a. Expression of Theme 5 points:
 - i. Does the calypso have a distinct recognizable theme? How well do the words support and develop the theme?
 - ii. Are the verses linked to the theme or are they scattered?
 - **iii.** Do the verses flow logically back into the chorus to re-enforce the theme and meaning of the song?
 - b. Word Craft 15 points:
 - i. Appropriateness of choice of words.
 - **ii.** Use of satire, subtlety, double entendre, irony, wit, humour, puns, play on word.
 - iii. Style and skill of composition
 - iv. Quality of rhyme
 - c. Substantive Content 15 points:
 - i. Marriage of lyric and melody/arrangement.
 - ii. Do the words complement each other smoothly and comfortably or is the song over-crowded with the singer having to rush the words to get them in?
 - iii. How smoothly do the lyrics flow along with the arrangement?
 - d. Creativity 5 points:
 - i. Unusually interesting interpretation of the topic, or the effective incorporation of local colour/experiences into the calypso.

The Music section is categorised into three (3) areas:

2. MUSIC - 30 POINTS:

a. Melody - 15 points:

- i. Strength and sweetness of the melody of verses, singing chorus and band chorus.
- **ii.** Does the tune carry the message effectively? Is it married to the lyrics in terms of measurement?
- iii. Does it capture the mood of the theme?

b. Arrangement - 10 points:

- i. Does it suit the mood and tempo?
- **ii.** Are particular instruments used to specially create and convey mood?
- iii. Does it have the proper key or orchestration?
- iv. Does the key carry the melody properly?
- v. Effectiveness of backup vocals, (if any).

c. Originality - 5 points:

- i. Are the melody and arrangement original?
- ii. Are pieces of other people's music included?
- iii. Are there novel musical ideas in the arrangement or melody?
- iv. Is there any successful incorporation of unusual musical instruments or combination of instruments.

The Performance section is categorised into two (2) areas:

3. PERFORMANCE - 25 POINTS:

a. Rendition - 15 points

- i. How the calypso is actually. Is it in calypso styles?
- **ii.** Does the singer use his voice effectively to interpret the song? Are there nuances of vocal chords?
- **iii.** Is the singer in the proper key? Is the manner of singing in keeping with the mood of the song?
- iv. How good is the diction?

b. Presentation - 10 points:

- i. The use of body, the hands, face, body contortions, energy.
- ii. The use of the stage.
- iii. The use of the microphone.
- iv. Are these being used to more effectively communicate the song and to improve the understanding of the lyrics?
